

## Cost of Attendance

Federal regulations require that the Financial Aid Office create a Cost of Attendance (COA) or “budget” each academic year. Cost of Attendance (COA) is the estimated cost of attending this institution for one academic year. This amount includes the following:

- Expected charges for one year of tuition and fees
  - Tuition – Charges assessed for classes
  - Fees – Charges assessed for other college services
- Room and board for resident students
- Estimated living expense -- allowance for rent, utilities, and food for off-campus living
- Estimated transportation costs
- Estimated books and supplies
- Miscellaneous costs
- Loan fees

Each institution will differ in what is allowed in their COA.

For 2022-2023 the COA Per Semester for the Psychiatric-Mental Health Nursing Practitioner Certificate program at Bluefield University is as follows:
