

Federal regulations require that the Financial Aid Office create a Cost of Attendance (COA) or “budget” each academic year. Cost of Attendance (COA) is the estimated cost of attending this institution for one academic year or per semester. This amount includes the following:

- Expected charges for one year of tuition and fees
 - Tuition – Charges assessed for classes
 - Fees – Charges assessed for other college services
- Room and board for resident students
- Estimated living expense -- allowance for rent, utilities, and food for off-campus living
- Estimated transportation costs
- Estimated books and supplies
- Miscellaneous costs
- Loan fees

Each institution will differ in what is allowed in their COA.

For 2023-2024 the COA Per Semester for the Associate of Ministerial Leadership program at Bluefield University is as follows:
