- Degree must be completed by May 1st of the anticipated year of enrollment
- GPA: Math and science coursework and last 60 credit hours GPAs must be 3.0 or greater
- Standardized exams: No entrance exam is required but applicants are encouraged to submit test scores to increase competitiveness
- Clinical experience: applicants with having worked in clinical healthcare more than five (5) years shall be exempted from prerequisite conferral requirement at the discretion of the program.
- Community service: highly recommended, but not required; does not have to be healthcare related
- Personal statement: no more than one page to illustrate the applicant's passion for patient care and the Anesthesiologist Assistant profession
- Letters of recommendation: one personal and two clinical references (preferably written by an AA/NA/RN/DO/MD/PA/NP) who have known you for six months or longer and can speak to your ability to be an AA; specifically your problem-solving, critical thinking and interpersonal skills
- Outstanding prerequisites: Applicants may apply with one outstanding prerequisite course; this course must be completed by December of the
  application year with grade of "B" or above and will not be calculated in GPA for consideration of admission.

## COVID-19 related considerations:

Calculus

- Prerequisite laboratory courses taken for credit (or pass) in calendar years 2020 or 2021 will be accepted, though a letter grade is preferred if possible. All lecture prerequisite courses must continue to be taken for a letter grade.
- Prerequisite courses taken online during calendar years 2020 and 2021 will be accepted without limitations.
