

Master of Health Science in Anesthesia Program

Guide to the REAP Application Process

- Program agreement** You do NOT have to complete an application through CASAA, however, you will be required to sign a program agreement- stating you will withhold all applications to other AA programs until after our final Admissions decisions have been made. You will receive this document via email.
- Prerequisite Courses** If there are any prerequisite courses specified for your intended program of study, you must successfully complete them with grades of B- or above prior to the start of matriculation
- Transcripts** Submit transcripts for all colleges, universities, technical schools, and diploma programs you have attended, thus far. You will submit your final transcripts upon completion of courses. Transcripts can be sent electronically or mailed.
- Wonderlic** Upon submission of your application you will be forwarded an invitation link to complete an online cognitive agility from www.wonderlic.com.
- Letters of Reference** Three letters of recommendation from persons familiar with graduate education to evaluate your qualifications for graduate study are required. These should include an academic reference, a clinical reference (if applicable) and a third professional person well-informed about relevant work you have done. The academic reference should preferably be from a faculty member who has taught you in class or academic advisor with whom you've worked throughout your college career.
- Personal Statement** A statement of your objectives for graduate study and your professional goals.
- Any License(s)** Send a photocopy of any current professional license(s) or certification(s) held (must include license/certificate number).
- Resume** Please provide a copy of your current resume.
- ACLS** ACLS certification is preferred (but not required) for admission to the Master of Health Science in Anesthesia Program.
- Anesthesia Shadow Experience** The MHSA Program recommends that every applicant be familiar with the practice of anesthesia and the operating room environment. Some applicants can meet this requirement with previous work experience or clinical experience. Others are highly encouraged to arrange to spend at least one day with an anesthesiologist or anesthesiologist in an operating room observing the administration of anesthesia and other patient care activities
- Interview** A personal interview with a member of the faculty, or designee, is required. You will be notified.
- International Applicants** If English is not your native language, a satisfactory score on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) is required prior to admission.
- Additional forms** Should you get accepted you will be required to fill out additional personal information required for enrollment, you will receive this paperwork via email from the Director of Admissions.
